

1. TOTAL ARRIVALS


Fig. 1: Total Arrivals, November 2009 - 2018

The total International Arrival Statistics recorded for the month of *November 2018* (Table 1), revealed a decrease of 14.8 percent over the previous month and an increase of 6.7 percent over the corresponding month of November 2017. (Refer Fig. 1)

As usual, air was the preferred mode of travel to Samoa, representing 96.8 percent (15,993) of total arrivals, while the remaining 3.2 percent (528) arrived by sea in November 2018.

2. TOTAL VISITORS

Overall Visitors numbered 11,483 for the month under review revealed a decrease of 20.9 percent over the previous month and a decrease of 5.2 percent when compared to the corresponding month of November 2017. (Refer Fig. 2).

Fig. 2: Total Visitors, November 2009 - 2018




Visitor arrivals have a strong seasonal pattern with a regular peak of numbers during holiday seasons normally December and July. The smoothed shortterm trend for visitor arrivals adjusting for seasonal pattern is shown in Appendix Graph 2.

3. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF ENTRY

Visitors, (table 2), made up the largest component of all arrivals with 32.5 percent (5,377) represented by males and 31.5 percent (5,211) by females.

Male returning residents made up 16.1 percent (2,655) of total arrivals while their female counterpart made up 14.4 percent (2,383). (Refer Fig. 3)

Fig. 3: Total Arrivals, by Purpose of Visit, November 2018




4. TOTAL VISITORS BY COUNTRY OF USUAL RESIDENCE

New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors' arrival by country of usual residence (Table 3) accounting for 45.7 percent or 5,252 of total visitors. Australia followed next with a distant 20.1 percent share (2,306).

The United States of America represented 7.9 percent (908) while America Samoa represented 7.5 percent (860) of total visitors. (Refer Fig. 4)

Fig. 4: Total Visitors, by Country of Usual Residence, November 2018




5. TOTAL VISITORS BY REGION

As usual, the Oceanic Region had the highest share of total visitors with 78.6 percent, followed by America with 8.3 percent.

Asia reported a share of 6.0 percent while Europe reported the least share with 5.9 percent. (Refer Fig. 5).

Fig. 5: Total Visitors by Region, November 2018




6. TOTAL VISITORS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT

The principal source markets (Table 4) namely New Zealand, American Samoa, Australia, and the United States of America constituted 81.2 percent of all visitors visiting Samoa in November 2018.

The majority of visitors (37.8 percent) entered our shores to visit friends and relatives while 36.7 percent entered our shores for holiday and vacation.

Those who were here for Business/ Conference recorded a share of 7.9 percent while those who were here on transit made up 4.7 percent. Fig.6 depicts total visitors by purpose of visit for November 2017 and November 2018.

Fig. 6: Total Visitors, by Purpose of Visit, November 2017 & November 2018




7. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY CARRIER

As depicted in table 5, Samoa Airways leads the way of arrival by carriers during the reference period with a 39.0 percent share (6,451 passengers) followed by Air New Zealand with 31.6 percent share (5,228 passengers).


Fig. 7: Total Arrivals by Carrier, November 2018

Fiji Airways brought in 11.8 percent (1,943 passengers) of total arrivals while Virgin Australia and Talofa Airwyas recorded shares of 8.8 percent (1,452) and 4.1 percent (682) respectively. Fig. 7 illustrates total arrivals by carrier during the reference period.

8. TOTAL VISITORS BY DURATION OF STAY AND PLACE OF STAY

As shown in Fig. 8 below, visitor's duration of stay in Samoa (Table 6) is between seven and thirty days.

On the other hand, the majority of visitors (53.7 percent or 5,880 visitors) reported staying in private accommodations or with families/ relatives while 41.0 percent (4,487) stayed in hotel/ motel. (Refer Fig. 9).

Fig. 9: Total Visitors by Place of Stay, November 2018





Fig. 10 portrays the number of visitors who stayed in hotels/ motels (4,487) by type of accommodation (hotel/ motel), within the reference month.

- (3) Apia Wharf (Matautu Port)


International arrival statistics are compiled on a monthly, quarterly and annual basis. These reports can also be extracted from our website: www.sbs.gov.ws

The migration report for the month of December 2018 will be released indefinitely due to the back log of the compilation of departure migration statistics for the third quarter of 2018.



Graph 3: Visitors Percentage Change over Previous month, November 2013 - November 2018


