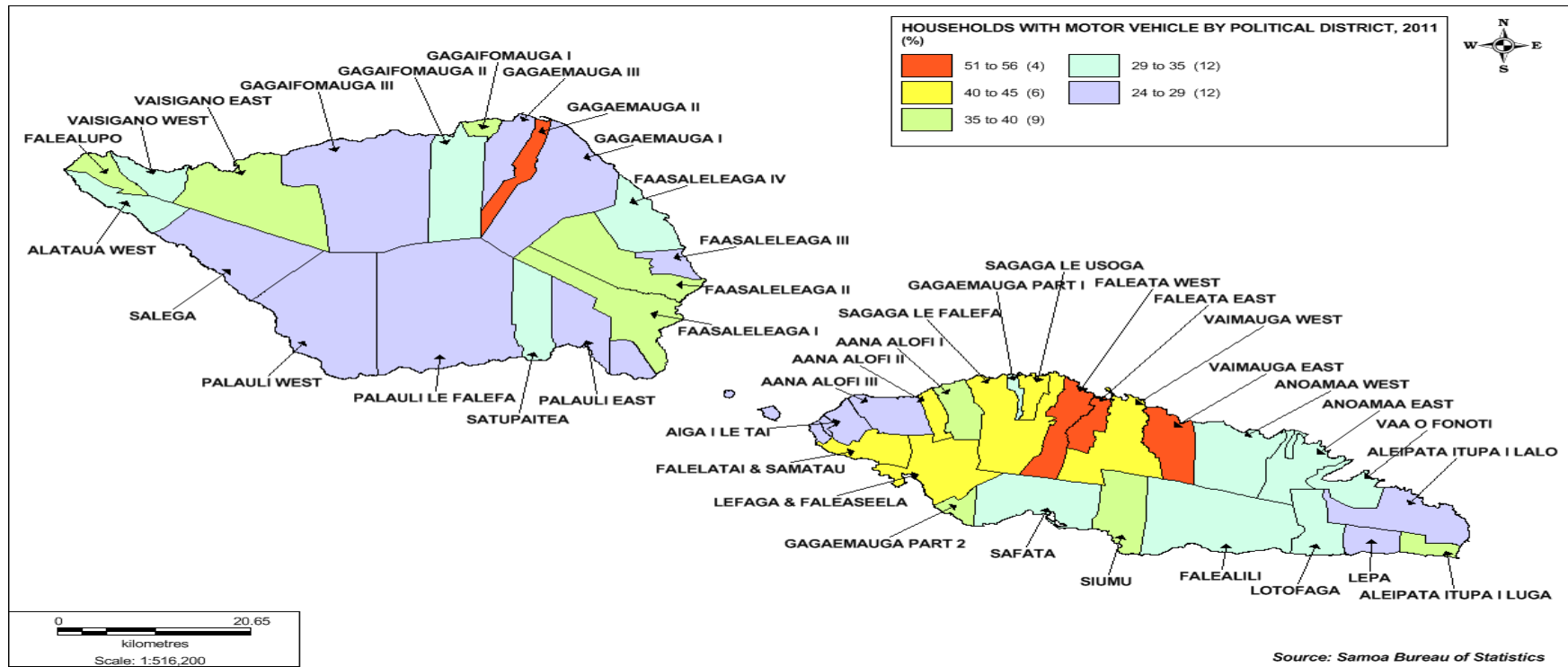


## PERCENTAGE OF HOUSEHOLDS THAT HAVE A MOTOR VEHICLE BY POLITICAL DISTRICT, 2011



Based on the Population and Housing Census 2011, there were **26,205 households** enumerated in Samoa and from this number, **40 percent or 10,521 households** have **motor vehicle (car)**. The above map shows the distribution of 10,521 households that have motor vehicle by political district in **percentage**. The **first colour (red)** shows that there are **4 political districts** that have the **highest percentage** of households with motor vehicle ranging from **(51 to 56) percent**. The **last colour (purple)** however shows that there are **12 political districts** with the **lowest percentage** of households that have motor vehicle ranging from **(24 to 29) percent**. Overall, out of the total number of households with motor vehicle (10,521) about **82 percent or 8,650 of households** in Upolu including (Manono & Apolima) compare to only **18 percent or 1,871 of households** in Savaii.
