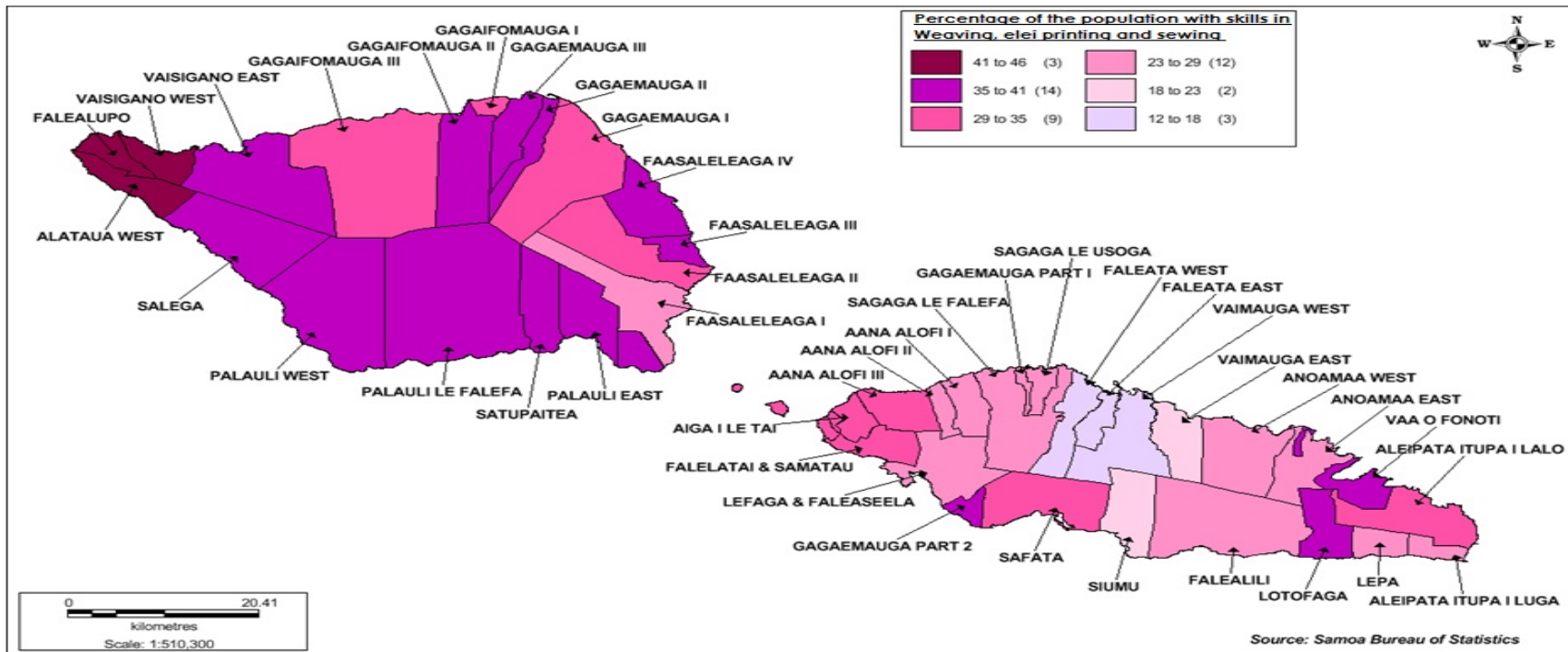


**PERCENTAGE OF SAMOA'S POPULATION WITH SKILLS IN WEAVING, ELEI PRINTING AND SEWING BY POLITICAL DISTRICT, 2011**



Out of **187,820** persons recorded in the Census 2011, about **115,900** persons were those in the working age of **15 years and over**. From the 115,900 people, only **25 percent** or **28,550** were persons with **skills in weaving, elei printing and sewing**. The map above shows the distribution of **28,550** persons with the mentioned skills by political districts in **percentage**. The **first colour (maroon)** indicates that there are **3 political districts** with the **highest percentage** of people with skills in weaving, elei printing and sewing ranging from **41 to 46 percent**. However, the **last colour (light purple)** tells that there are **3 political districts** with the **lowest percentage** of people with the same skills, ranging from **12 to 18 percent**.

Overall, out of the total number of people (**28,850**) with skills in weaving, elei printing and sewing, **67 percent** or **19,270** lived on Upolu Island including (Manono and Apolima) compared to only **33 percent** or **9,280** that lived on Savaii Island.
