

# **Import Price Index** September 2025 Quarter

(Base Period: March 2018 Quarter=100.0)

### Highlights of the quarter

(September quarter 2025 compared to June quarter 2025)


- The Import Price Index increased by 2.8% from the June quarter 2025.
- Animal products recorded the largest increase of 9.4%.

### **Overview**

The Import Price Index for the September quarter 2025 showed an overall increase of 2.8% from the previous quarter. This was mainly driven by the 9.4% increase in the price of animal products. In addition, the import price index for beverages rose by 3.7%, fats and oils by 2.4%, and food and mineral products by 0.4%. When compared to the September quarter 2024, the import price index fell by 1.7%.

The overall import price index for the four quarters ending September 2025 was 4.1% lower compared to the four quarters ending September 2024.

### **HS Section 1: Animal Products rose 9.4%**


The import price index for animal products in the September guarter 2025 increased by 9.4% from the previous quarter. This was mainly driven by higher prices of meat products (up 11.3%) and dairy products (up 3.9%). The increase was reflected in higher import prices for poultry meat (up 11.8%) and cheese (up 38.1%), to name a few. In addition, the animal products index increased by 11.8% compared to the September 2024 quarter.

In the year ending September 2025, the overall index increased by 9.4 percent over the year ending September 2024.








### HS Section 2: Vegetable Products fell 6.2%

The import price index for vegetable products was 6.2% lower compared to the previous quarter. This was driven by lower import prices of vegetable products (down 27.2%), such as onions (down 27.8%) and potatoes (down 26.5%). When compared to the same quarter last year, the vegetable products index fell by 1.2%. Furthermore, the overall vegetable product index for the year ending September 2025 was 1.1% lower than the index for the year ending September 2024. (See tables 1 & 2 and graph 3).




#### HS Section 3: Fats & Oils rose 2.4%

The import price index for animal or vegetable fats and oil products rose 2.4% in the September quarter 2025, reflecting higher import prices for margarine (up 15.8%). The animal or vegetable oils index increased by 9.4% compared to the corresponding quarter last year.

The import price index rose by 4.0% in the year ending September 2025 compared to the year ending September 2024.




### **HS Section 4: Food & Beverage rose 3.7%**

The import price index for food and beverage products increased by 3.7% in the September quarter 2025 compared to the previous quarter. This was due to higher import prices for canned meat (up 8.7%) and sugar (up 7.6%). When compared to the corresponding quarter of 2024, the food and beverage index increased by 4.1%. However, the overall index for the year ending September 2025 declined by 1.7% compared to the same period ending September 2024. (See tables 1 & 2 and graph 5).








### **HS Section 5: Mineral Products rose 0.4%**

The import price index for mineral products recorded an increase of 0.4% compared to the June quarter 2025. This was driven by higher prices for petroleum gases (up 25.7%). On the other hand, the mineral products index was 12.3% lower compared to the September guarter of 2024.

For the year ending September 2025, the index fell by 12.8% compared to the year ending September 2024. (See tables 1 & 2 and graph 6).



#### **Technical Notes**

The Import Price Index (MPI) measures changes in the cost, insurance, and freight (CIF) prices of imports of merchandise into Samoa. It is a fixed weight index with March 2018 quarter = 100.0 and is calculated on a quarterly basis using the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS). The items included in the index were selected based on their significance to the total imports.

The scope of the MPI covers the following sections of the International Harmonized System of Trade Classification (HS): 1. Live Animals: Animal Products, 2. Vegetable Products, 3. Animal or Vegetable fats and oils, 4. Food and Beverages, and 5. Mineral Products. The index represents 50 percent of total Imports.

The IPI report for December 2025 is expected to be available on February 13, 2026.


