January – June 2025

Highlights of the six months period

- The total number of seagoing vessels cleared at the port of Apia was 207.
- Total number of seagoing vessels accepted for tabulation was 115, which consisted of 76 Container vessels, 26 General Cargo Vessels, and 13 Mineral Oil Tankers.
- 99 vessels carried inward cargo.
- 51 vessels returned with outward cargo

Overview: Number of Vessels

The total number of international seagoing vessels cleared at the port of Apia in the first six months (January-June) of 2025 was 207. Of the total, 115 international seagoing vessels were accepted for tabulation, which consisted of 76 Container vessels, 26 General Cargo vessels, and 13 Mineral Oil Tankers. There were 92 vessels excluded from tabulation as they did not have the required information. These vessels included Research/Naval, Yacht, Cruise ships and Fishing vessels.

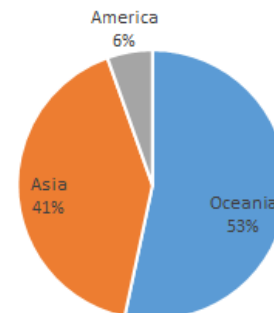

Cargo Discharged by Region

The analysis of cargo discharged at the port of Apia indicated that 99 vessels discharged a combined total of 205,836 metric tonnes of cargo, of which 53 percent (109,783 metric tonnes) from Oceania (mostly from Fiji and New Zealand), 41 percent (84,870 metric tonnes) came from the Asia region (mostly from Singapore), and 6 percent (11,181 metric tonnes) from the America region.

Figure 2. Cargo Discharged by Region Jan - Jun 2025

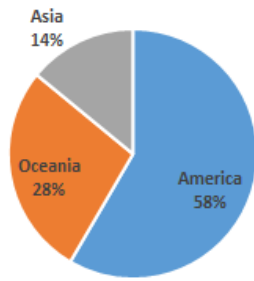


Cargo Loaded by Region

51 vessels loaded a combined total of 33,916 metric tonnes of cargo, of which 58 percent (19,813 metric tonnes) were loaded for the America region (USA), 28 percent (9,331 metric tonnes) were loaded for the Oceania region (mostly to Fiji) and the remaining 14 percent (4,772 metric tonnes) were loaded for the Asia region (mostly to Taiwan and Korea).

Jan - Jun 2025**



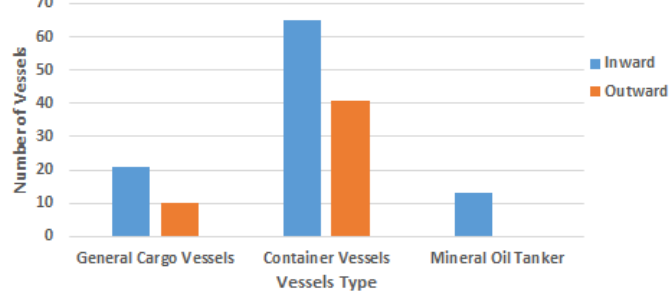
Vessels carried inward/outward cargo

Of the 115¹ vessels that arrived, only 99 vessels carried inward cargo, and 51 vessels returned with outward cargo.

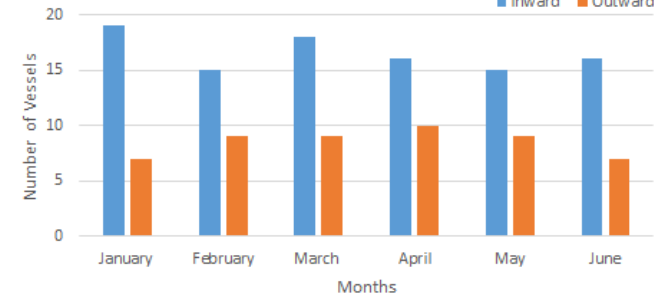
The 99 vessels that carried inward cargo consisted of 65 Container vessels, 21 General Cargo vessels, and 13 Mineral Oil Tanker vessels, while the 51 vessels that returned with outward cargo consisted of 41 Container vessels and 10 General Cargo vessels.

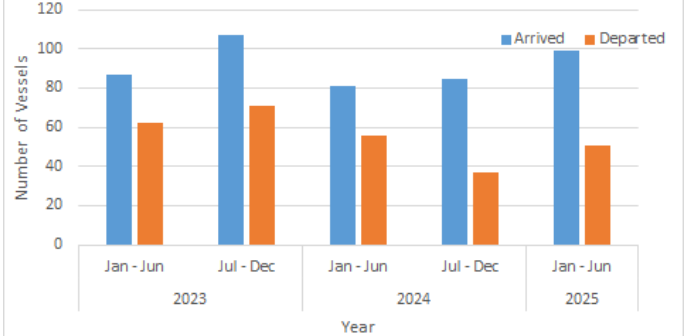
**Figure 5. Number of Vessels that carried Inward/Outward Cargo by Month

Figures 4 and 5 illustrate the graphical analysis of the number of vessels that carried inward/outward cargo by type during the reference period.

Jan - Jun 2025**

Jan - Jun 2025**



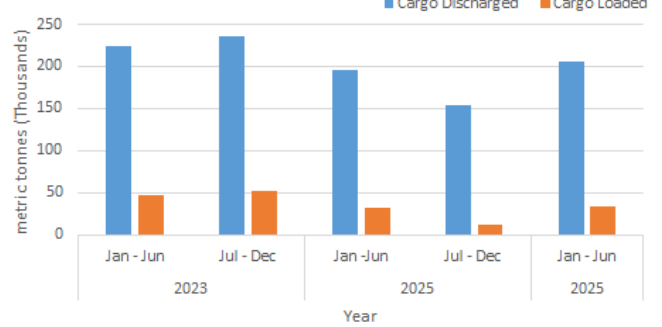
A comparative analysis of the six-month shipping reports in the last two years (2022-2025) revealed that the total number of vessels² that arrived ranged from 81 to 107, while vessels³ that departed ranged from 37 to 71

Moreover, cargo discharged ranged from 116,273 to 224,544 metric tonnes while cargo loaded ranged from 20,868 to 146,740 metric tonnes.

2023-2025**

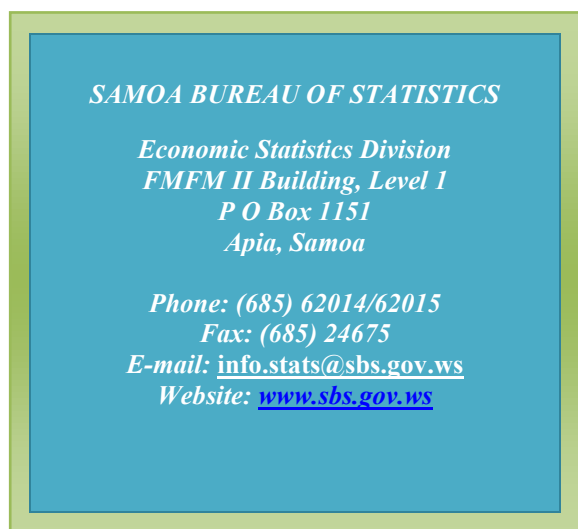

Technical notes

Data for the Shipping Statistics Report published by the Samoa Bureau of Statistics were collected mainly from Shipping Statistic Forms and cargo manifests, which were completed by Shipping agents and Stevedores as a port requirement for every international seagoing vessel. This report excludes all domestic services and the Apia-Pago Pago route. Furthermore, if a vessel calls in more than once, its subsequent calls are recorded as a separate vessel.

Definitions

DWT (Dead Weight Tonnage)

Is the number of tons of cargo, store, etc., that a vessel is capable of carrying when floating at her load draught.

GRT (Gross Registered Tonnage)

Is the measure of the total internal volume of the ship, and is equal to the number of deck tonnage plus the tonnage of all enclosed space above the tonnage deck.

NRT (Net Registered Tonnage)

Is the residual tonnage after the various allowances for propelling, power, crew spaces, and navigation spaces have been deducted from the gross tonnage.

- = Magnitude is zero

0 = Negligible

Container Vessel

A vessel has been instant with cell guides to carry containers.

Mineral Oil Tanker vessel

A vessel designed and constructed to carry Mineral Oil – in – bulk.

General Cargo Vessel

A vessel designed and constructed to carry general cargoes.
