



# Shipping Statistics Report

## July – December 2025

File Ref: SR Jul - Dec 2025

### Highlights of the six months period

- Total number of sea-going vessels cleared at the Port of Apia was 228
- Total number of sea-going vessels accepted for tabulation was 104, comprising 71 Container Vessels, 20 General Cargo Vessels, and 13 Mineral Oil Tankers.
- 101 vessels carried inward cargo.
- 75 vessels departed with outward cargo

### Overview: Number of vessels

The total number of international sea-going vessels cleared at the port of Apia in the last six months of 2025 (July - December) was 228. Of the total, 104 international seagoing vessels were accepted for tabulation, which consisted of 71 Container vessels, 20 General Cargo vessels, and 13 Mineral Oil Tankers. The remaining 124 vessels were excluded from tabulation due to incomplete or missing information. These vessels included Research/Naval, Yacht, Cruise ships, and Fishing vessels.

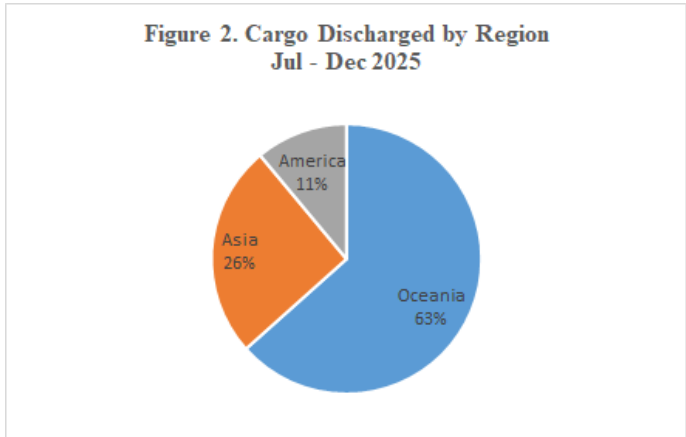
**Figure 1. Number of vessels by type and percentages**

### Cargo Discharged

The analysis of cargo discharged at the port of Apia indicated that 101 vessels discharged a combined total of 265,557 metric tonnes of cargo, of which 63.0% (168,333 metric tonnes) from Oceania (mostly from New Zealand and Fiji), 26.0% (67,806 metric tonnes) came from the Asian region (mostly from Singapore), and 11.0% (29,359 metric tonnes) from the American region.

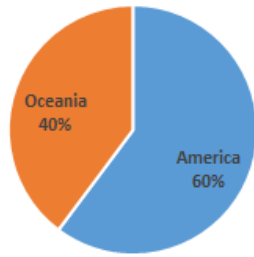

### Cargo Loaded

There were 75 vessels that loaded a combined total of 56,424 metric tonnes of cargo, of which 60% (33,985 metric tonnes) were loaded for the American region (USA), 40% (22,438 metric tonnes) were loaded for the Oceania region (mostly to New Zealand)

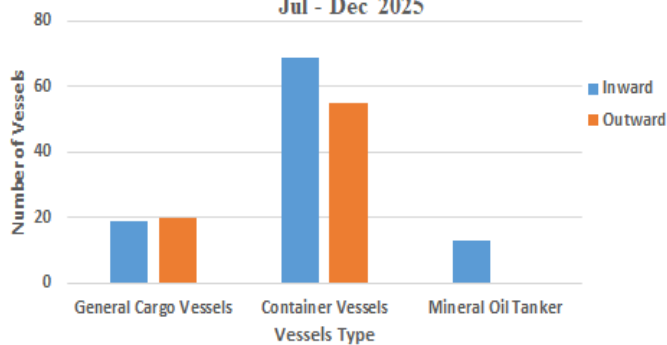
### Vessels carried inward/outward cargo

Of the 104<sup>1</sup> vessels that arrived, only 101 vessels carried inward cargo, and 75 vessels returned with outward cargo.

The 101 vessels that carried inward cargo consisted of 69 Container vessels, 19 General Cargo vessels, and 13 Mineral Oil Tanker vessels, while the 75 vessels that returned with outward cargo consisted of 55 Container vessels and 20 General Cargo vessels.

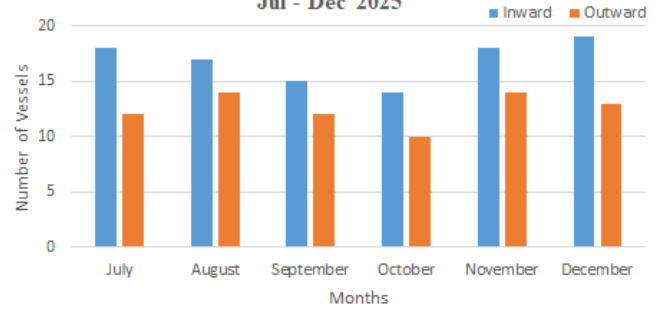

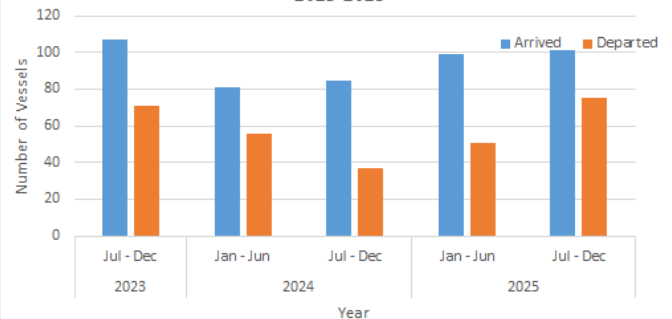
A comparative analysis of the six-month shipping reports in the last three years (2023-2025) revealed that the total number of vessels<sup>2</sup> that arrived ranged from 81 to 107, while vessels<sup>3</sup> that departed ranged from 37 to 75

Moreover, cargo discharged ranged from 153,342 to 265,557 metric tonnes while cargo loaded ranged from 13,008 to 56,424 metric tonnes.

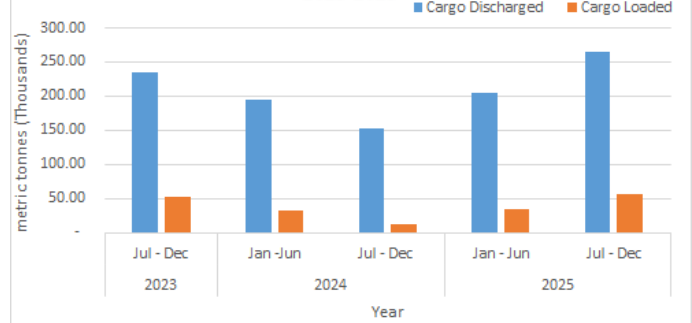

The attached Tables 1-7 provide more detailed analysis of international sea going vessels, and cargo loaded and discharged at the port of Apia within the reference period.

The first six months of 2026 (Jan – Jun 2026) report will be available on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2026.

## Technical Notes

Data for the Shipping Statistics Report published by the Samoa Bureau of Statistics are collected mainly from Shipping Statistics Forms and cargo manifests, which were completed by Shipping agents and Stevedores as a port requirement for every international sea going vessel. This report excludes all domestic services and the Apia-Pago Pago route. Furthermore, if a vessel calls in more than once, its subsequent calls are recorded as a separate vessel.

### Definitions

#### DWT (Dead Weight Tonnage)

Is the number of tons of cargo, store, etc., that a vessel is capable of carrying when floating at her load draught.

#### GRT (Gross Registered Tonnage)

Is the measure of the total internal volume of the ship, and is equal to the number deck tonnage plus the tonnage of all enclosed space above the tonnage deck.

#### NRT (Net Registered Tonnage)

Is the residual tonnage after the various allowances for propelling, power, crew spaces, and navigation spaces have been deducted from the gross tonnage.

- = Magnitude is zero

0 = Negligible

#### Container Vessel

A vessel has been fitted with cell guides specifically designed to carry containers.

#### Mineral Oil Tanker vessel

A vessel designed and constructed to carry Mineral Oil – in – bulk.

#### General Cargo Vessel

A vessel designed and constructed to carry general cargo.
