INTERNATIONAL ARRIVAL STATISTICS JANUARY 2024

MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS:

In January 2024 compared with January 2023:

- ✤ Total arrivals of 20,619, increased by 18.5% (3,220)
- Total visitors of 14,520, increased by 17.8% (2,199)
- Total Visitors:
 - ✓ NZ: 1.0% (up by 65 visitors)
 - ✓ AUST: 51.1% (up by 1,432 visitors)
 - ✓ USA: 21.6% (up by 178 visitors)
 - ✓ AM. SAM: 19.6% (up by 145) visitors)


1. TOTAL ARRIVALS

The total International Arrival Statistics recorded for the month of *January 2024* totalling 20,619 arrivals, revealed a decrease of 31.8 percent over the previous month of December 2023 and an increase of 18.5 percent over the corresponding month of January 2023.

Those who travelled to Samoa by Air represented 94.8% while 5.2% was represented by those who travelled by Sea.

Fig. 1 below graphically depicts the arrival numbers for January between 2015 and 2024, clearly showing the impact of Covid 19 on arrival numbers for January in 2021 and 2022.

Fig. 1: January Total Arrivals, 2015 – 2024




2. TOTAL VISITORS

Overall visitor numbers for the month under review stood at 14,520 revealing a decrease of 35.5 percent over the previous month of December 2023 and an increase of 17.8 percent over the corresponding month of January 2023.

Fig. 2 illustrates the total number of visitors for January between 2015 and 2024, indicating the impact of Covid-19 on visitor numbers for January in 2021 and 2022.

Fig. 2: January Total Visitors, 2015 – 2024




3. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF ENTRY

Visitors, (Table 2), made up the largest component of all arrivals with 61.3 percent (12,637), represented by 31.5 percent females (6,491) and 29.8 percent males (6,146).

Male returning residents made up 15.5 percent (3,204) of total arrivals while their female counterpart made up 14.0 percent (2,895). (Refer Fig. 3)

Fig. 3: Total Arrivals, by Purpose of Entry, January 2024





4. TOTAL VISITORS BY COUNTRY OF USUAL RESIDENCE

New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors' arrival by country of usual residence (Table 3) accounting for 45.2 percent of total visitors or 6,561 visitors. Australia followed next with a distant 29.1 percent share (4,232).

United States of America reported 6.9 percent (1,002 visitors) while American Samoa reported 6.1 percent (883) of total visitors. (Refer Fig. 4)

Fig. 4: Total Visitors, by Country of Usual Residence, January 2024




5. TOTAL VISITORS BY REGION

As usual, the Oceanic Region had the highest share of total visitors with 85.7 percent, followed by America with 7.1 percent.

Asia reported a share of 4.6 percent while Europe reported the least share of 2.0 percent. (Refer Fig. 5).

Fig. 5: Total Visitors by Region, January 2024




6. TOTAL VISITORS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT

The principal source markets (Table 4) namely New Zealand, Australia, American Samoa and the United States of America constitute 87.3 percent of all visitors visiting Samoa in January 2024.

The majority of visitors (6,047) entered our shores to visits friends and relatives while 5,172 entered our shores for holiday/ vacation.

Those who were here for Business/Conference recorded 567 visitors while those who visit Samoa for Sports purposes reported only 21 visitors. Fig.6 depicts total visitors by purpose of visit for January 2023 and January 2024.

Fig. 6: Total Visitors, by Purpose of Visit, January 2023 & January 2024




7. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY CARRIER

As depicted in table 5, Air New Zealand brought in the highest share of passengers to Samoa with 41.9 percent (8,646 passengers) followed by Fiji Airways with a 20.7 percent share (4,266 passengers).


Fig. 7: Total Arrivals by Carrier, January 2024

Virgin Australia brought in 10.1 percent (2,081 passengers) of total arrivals while Samoa Airways and Quantas recorded shares of 8.7 percent (1,788) and 8.2 percent (1,694) respectively. Fig. 7 illustrates total arrivals by carrier during the reference period.

8. TOTAL VISITORS BY DURATION OF STAY AND PLACE OF STAY

As shown in Fig. 8 below, visitor's duration of stay in Samoa (Table 6) is between seven and thirty days.





On the other hand, the majority of visitors (69.0 percent or 9,626 visitors) reported staying in private accomodations or with families/ relatives while 26.2 percent (3,653) stayed in hotel/ motel. (Refer Fig. 9).







Fig. 10 portrays the number of visitors who stayed in hotels/ motels (3,653) by type of accommodation (hotel/ motel), during the reference month.


The sourced documents for the compilation of International Arrival Statistics are the immigration arrival and departure card forms.


These forms are completed by all incoming and outgoing travelers at the two local points of entry namely:

(2) Apia Wharf (Matautu Port)
(3) Fagalii International Airport


Futhermore, the BMS (Border Management Sytem) is also used for the compilation of such statistics.




Note: Covid-19 travel restriction period from 20th March 2020 to 31st July 2022
