# INTERNATIONAL ARRIVAL STATISTICS MARCH 2024

# MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS:


#### 1. TOTAL ARRIVALS

The total International Arrival Statistics recorded for the month of *March 2024* totalling 16,257 arrivals, revealed an increase of 15.5 percent over the previous month of February 2024 and an increase of 9.4 percent over the corresponding month of March 2023.

Those who travelled to Samoa by Air represented 93.6% while 6.4% was represented by those who travelled by Sea.

Fig. 1 below graphically depicts the arrival numbers from March 2015 to March 2024, clearly showing the impact of Covid 19 on arrival numbers for March in 2021 and 2022.

Fig. 1: March Total Arrivals, 2015 - 2024




### 2. TOTAL VISITORS

Overall visitor numbers for the month under review stood at 11,242 revealing an increase of 16.7 percent over the previous month of February 2024 and an increase of 11.0 percent over the corresponding month of March 2023.

Fig. 2 illustrates the total number of visitors for March between 2015 and 2024, also indicating the impact of Covid 19 on visitors numbers for March in 2021 and 2022.

Fig. 2: March Total Visitors, 2015 - 2024




#### 3. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF ENTRY

Visitors, (Table 2), made up the largest component of all arrivals with 60.4 percent (9,825), represented by 31.1 percent males (5,054) and 29.3 percent females (4,771).

Male returning residents made up 17.3 percent (2,806) of total arrivals while their female counterpart made up 13.6 percent (2,209). (Refer Fig. 3)

Fig. 3: Total Arrivals, by Purpose of Entry, March 2024




#### 4. TOTAL VISITORS BY COUNTRY OF USUAL RESIDENCE

New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors' arrival by country of usual residence (Table 3) accounting for 39.7 percent of total visitors or 4,463 visitors. Australia followed next with a distant 24.9 percent share (2,801).

United States of America reported 9.5 percent (1,064 visitors) while American Samoa reported 6.4 percent (719) of total visitors. (Refer Fig. 4)

Fig. 4: Total Visitors, by Country of Usual Residence, March 2024




#### 5. TOTAL VISITORS BY REGION

As usual, the Oceanic Region had the highest share of total visitors with 76.5 percent, followed by America with 9.6 percent.

Asia reported a share of 9.2 percent while Europe reported the least share of 4.1 percent. (Refer Fig. 5).

Fig. 5: Total Visitors by Region, March 2024




### 6. TOTAL VISITORS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT

The principal source markets (Table 4) namely New Zealand, Australia, American Samoa and the United States of America constitute 80.5 percent of all visitors visiting Samoa in March 2024.

The majority of visitors (3,897) entered our shores for holiday and vacation while 3,776 entered our shores to visit friends and relatives.

Those who were here on Business/Conference recorded 938 visitors while those for Sports purposes reported only 44 visitors. Fig.6 depicts total visitors by purpose of visit for March 2023 and March 2024.

Fig. 6: Total Visitors, by Purpose of Visit, March 2023 & March 2024




#### 7. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY CARRIER

As depicted in table 5, Air New Zealand carried the highest share of passengers to Samoa with a 39.8 percent share, (6,474 passengers) followed by Fiji Airways with a 25.1 percent share (4,076 passengers).


Fig. 7: Total Arrivals by Carrier, March 2024

Samoa Airways brought in 9.9 percent (1,617 passengers) of total arrivals while Virgin Australia and Talofa Airways recorded shares of 8.3 percent (1,349) and 5.6 percent (907) respectively. Fig. 7 illustrates total arrivals by carrier during the reference period.

# 8. TOTAL VISITORS BY DURATION OF STAY AND PLACE OF STAY

As shown in Fig. 8 below, visitor's duration of stay in Samoa (Table 6) is between seven and thirty days.

On the other hand, the majority of visitors (57.7 percent or 6,211 visitors) reported staying in private accommodations or with families/ relatives while 36.3 percent (3,909) stayed in hotel/motel. (Refer Fig. 9).

Fig. 9: Total Visitors by Place of Stay, March 2024





Fig. 10 portrays the number of visitors who stayed in hotels/motels (3,909) by type of accommodation (hotel/ motel), within the reference month.

The sourced documents for the compilation of International Arrival Statistics are the immigration arrival and departure card forms.


These forms are completed by all incoming and outgoing travelers at the two local points of entry namely:

- (1) Faleolo International Airport
- (2) Apia Wharf (Matautu Port)
- (3) Fagalii International Airport

Futhermore, the BMS (Border Management Sytem) was also used for the compilation of such statistics.


International Arrival Statistics are compiled on a monthly, quarterly and annual basis. These reports can also be downloaded from our website: www.sbs.gov.ws

Graph 1: Monthly Total Arrivals, March 2019 - March 2024




