1. <u>ARRIVALS</u>


1. TOTAL ARRIVALS


Fig. 1.1: 3rd Quarter Total Arrivals, 2015 - 2025

The total International Arrival Statistics documented for the reference period (table 1), revealed an increase of 9.8 percent over the previous quarter (Aprl-June 2025) and an increase of 1.1 percent over the corresponding quarter of 2024. Fig.1.1 reveals the impact of Covid 19 on arrival numbers in 2020, 2021 and 2022. (Refer Fig. 1.1).

As usual, air being the most preferred mode of travel to Samoa, representing 93.7 percent of total arrivals, while those that arrived by sea accounted for the remaining 6.3 percent.

Fig 1.1 illustrates the impact of Coivd - 19 on the number of 2nd quarterly arrivals for 2020, 2021 and 2022.

1.2. TOTAL VISITORS

Total Visitors of 52,144 for the quarter under review revealed an increase of 16.1 percent over the previous quarter and an increase of 2.6 percent when compared to the correseponding quarter of 2024. Fig.1.2 also reveals the impact of Covid - 19 on the number of 3rd quarterly visitor numbers recorded in 2020,2021 and 2022.

Fig. 1.2: 3rd Quarter Total Visitors, 2015 - 2025




1.3 TOTAL ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF ENTRY

Visitors, including transit, made up the largest component of all arrivals with 37.5 percent (25,776) recorded for females and 35.0 percent (24,014) for males.


Fig. 1.3: Percentage distribution of Total Arrivals by Purpose of Visit, 3rd Quarter 2025

Male and female returning residents made up 142 percent (9,734) and 9.9 percent (6,783) respectively of total arrivals while Temporary residents made up 2.0 percent (1,379) for males and 1.4 percent (975) for females. (Refer Fig. 1.3).

1.4 VISITORS BY COUNTRY OF USUAL RESIDENCE

New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors' arrival by country of usual residence (Table 3) accounting for 47.6 percent or 24,838 of total visitors. Australia followed next with a distant 25.6 percent share (13,366). U.S.A recorded a share of 9.2 percent (4,775) followed by American Samoa with a share of 4.8 percent (2,477). (Refer Fig. 1.4)

Fig. 1.4: Percentage distribution of Total Visitors by Country of Usual Residence, 3rd Quarter 2025




1.5 VISITORS BY REGION

As usual, the Oceania Region had the highest share of total visitors with 81.9 percent, followed by America with 9.4 percent

Asia reported a share of 5.3 percent while Europe reported the least share with 3.1 percent. (Refer Fig. 1.5).

Fig. 1.5: Percentage distribution of Total Visitors by Region, 3rd Quarter 2025




1.6 VISITORS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT

As depicted in Table 4, New Zealand, Australia, American Samoa, and the United States of America constituted 872 percent of all visitors visiting Samoa while other countries round up the remaining 12.8 percent during the reference period.

Visitors that entered our shores for holiday/vacations accounted for 51.2 percent of all visitors. Those who were here to visit friends and relatives accounted for 33.2 percent while those that travelled for Business and Conference made up 6.4 percent of total visitors.

Visiting for other purposes accounted for 4.4 percent while transients bound for other destinations and sports registered 3.3 and 1.4 percent respectively. Fig. 1.6 depicts total visitors by purpose of visit during the reference period compared to the corresponding quarter of 2024.

Fig. 1.6: Total Visitors by Purpose of Visit, 3rd Quarter 2024 & 3rd Quarter 2025




1.7 TOTAL ARRIVALS BY CARRIER

As tabulated in Table 5, Air New Zealand leads the way for arrivals by carriers during the reference period with a 40.4 percent share (27,725 passengers) followed by Fiji Airways with a share of 24.4 percent (16,727 passengers).


Fig. 1.7: Percentage distribution of Total Arrivals by Carrier, 3rd Quarter 2025

Quantas recorded a 9.1 percent share (6,238), Samoa Airways had a share of 8.5 percent (5,818) while Virgin Australia and Talofa Airways recorded shares of 6.0 percent (4,105) and 5.3 percent (3,609) respectively. Fig. 1.7 illustrates total arrivals by carrier during the reference period.

1.8 VISITORS DURATION AND PLACE OF STAY


The usual trend of visitor's duration of stay in Samoa (Table 6) is between 7 days and 30 days, as revealed in Fig 1.8 below.

On the other hand, 49.5 percent (24,987) stayed in private accommodations or with families/relatives while 42.7 percent (21,553) of total visitors reported staying in hotel/ motels. (Refer Fig. 1.9).

- (3) Apia Wharf (Matautu Port)


Futhermore, the BMS (Border Management System) was aslo used for the compilation of such statistics.


Graph 1: Quarterly Total Arrivals, 3rd Quarter 2015 - 3rd Quarter 2025
