Annual Shipping Statistics 2021

Highlights of the year 2021

- 196 international sea going vessels were accepted for tabulation which consisted of 122 container vessels, 52 General Cargo Vessels, and 22 Mineral Oil Tankers.
- 176 vessels carried inward cargo
- 132 vessels returned with outward cargo

Overview

Number of vessels

In 2021, there were 323 international sea going vessels cleared at the port of Apia. Of the total, 196 international sea going vessels were accepted for tabulation. These consisted of 122 Container Vessels, 52 General Cargo Vessels, and 22 Mineral Oil Tankers. There were 127 vessels excluded from the analysis because they did not have the required information. These vessels included Research/Naval, Yacht Cruise Ships and Fishing Vessels.


Figure 1. Number of vessels by type and percenatge

Cargo Discharged

The analysis of cargo discharged at the port of Apia indicated that 176¹ vessels discharged a combined total of 337,378 thousand metric tonnes of cargo, of which 51 percent (179,155 metric tonnes) came from the Oceania region (mostly from New Zealand and Fiji), 36 percent (121,697 metric tonnes) came from the Asia region (mostly from Singapore and Korea), 13 percent (44,415 metric

tonnes) came from the America region (mostly from the USA).


Cargo Loaded

There were 132² vessels that loaded a combined total of 187,701 metric tonnes of cargo, of which 75 percent (140,510 metric tonnes) were loaded for the Oceania region (mostly to Tonga and New Zealand), 23 percent (7,250 metric tonnes) were loaded for the America region (all to the USA) and the remaining 2 percent (4,409 metric tonnes) were loaded for the Asia region (mostly to China, Korea and Thailand).



Vessels that carried inward/outward cargo

Of the 196³ vessels that arrived, 176 carried inward cargo and 132 vessels returned with outward cargo.


The 176 vessels that carried inward cargo consisted of 118 Container vessels, 36 General Cargo and 22 Mineral Oil Tanker vessels. The 132 vessels that returned with outward cargo consisted of 87 Container vessels and 45 General Cargo vessels.





Technical notes

Data for the Shipping Statistics Report published by the Samoa Bureau of Statistics were collected mainly from Shipping Statistic Forms and cargo manifests, which were completed by Shipping agents and Stevedores as a port requirement for every international sea going vessel. This report excludes all domestic services and the Apia-Pago Pago route. Furthermore, if a vessel calls in more than once, its subsequent calls are recorded as a separate vessel.

Definitions

DWT (Dead Weight Tonnage)

Is the number of tons of cargo, store, etc., that a vessel is capable of carrying when floating at her load draught.

GRT (Gross Registered Tonnage)

Is the measure of the total internal volume of the ship, and is equal to the number deck tonnage plus the tonnage of all enclosed space above the tonnage deck.

NRT (Net Registered Tonnage)

Is the residual tonnage after the various allowances for propelling, power, crew spaces, and navigation spaces have been deducted from the gross tonnage

Container Vessel

A vessel has been instant with cell guides to carry containers.

Mineral Oil Tanker vessel

A vessel designed and constructed to carry Mineral Oil-in-bulk.

General Cargo Container

A vessel designed and constructed to carry general cargoes.
