### Overseas Merchandise Trade October 2019

#### **Highlights of the month**

*October 2019 compared with September 2019*

#### **Merchandise Exports<sup>1</sup>**

- The total value of merchandise exports increased 5.3 percent (to \$12.99 million).
- 'Food and Live Animal' exports had the largest increase (up \$711 thousand).
- Asia had the largest increase from the previous month (\$648 thousand), with Japan the main driver of the current increase (up \$829 thousand).
- Oceania had the largest share of total exports value with 71.2 percent, reflecting higher values of exports to American Samoa (\$5.59 million).

#### **Merchandise Imports**

- The total value of merchandise imports increased 21.5 percent (to \$95.5 million)
- The current increase was mainly led by a huge increase of 'Mineral fuels, mineral oils and products' (up by \$14.9 million).
- Asia recorded the largest share of total imports value (47.5 million) and also had the largest increase from the previous month (up by \$14.3 million), with Singapore the main driver of the current increase (up by \$14.5 million).
- New Zealand remained as the leading country for imports, accounting for 26.2 percent of total imports value.


#### **Trade Balance**

- The total value of imports (\$95.5 million) exceeded that of exports (\$12.99 million), resulting in a trade deficit of \$82.5 million.
